WHO SHOULD SIGN UP

System Admin

This is a comprehensive training that covers all aspects of managing your Rev tenant, including provisioning/editing accounts, enabling features, configuring distribution, and managing devices. Users taking this training should be System Admins and will need to have an Account Admin role in Rev.

Event Admin

In this training, Event Admins learn how to create events and edit their settings, as well as start events. Users taking this training should be Event Admins and have a Event Admin, Event Host, or Account Admin role in Rev.

Content Admin

Anyone who will be responsible for managing content, such as creating and uploading videos or setting access permissions, should participate in this training session. These users will need to have a Media Admin, Media Contributor, or Account Admin role in Rev.

End User

The end user training covers the basics of how to use Rev: view live and on-demand video, use the search feature, subscribe to channels, and create playlists. The users taking this training should be Media Viewers and have a Media Viewer role in Rev.
